

FAQ for Bowling

- Q: Our school wants to sign up for IESA Bowling what do I do?
- A: Congratulations, we're excited to have you! Here is important information you need to know:
- 1. Your school must be an IESA member school. If you are unsure if you are or not, check with your school administration or contact our office at 309-829-0114. If your school is not an IESA member school, your school administration must complete this process through our office before any bowling sign-up can happen.
- 2. Once registered as an IESA member school, school administration must complete the bowling sign-up process:
 - Log in to the member center using the school password.
 - In the menu, choose "Registration and Entry Center Logins."
 - On the left side, choose "Bowling" for the desired school year.
 - Select the number of students you want to register you will provide us with those students' names AFTER we receive payment.
 - You can have a maximum of 4 boys and 4 girls (8 students total).
 - The cost listed is <u>per student.</u>
 - Fees double after the initial entry deadline and registration won't be taken if it is not postmarked by the final entry deadline.
 - Click "Proceed to Step #2" and confirm the number of entries.
 - Print the invoice and submit it with a school-issued check to IESA.
 - Your registration is complete once IESA receives your check.
- 3. Once registered for IESA Bowling, you are automatically added to the mailing list and will be sent reminder emails regarding roster deadlines and state competition information. You will also get an initial mailing sent to the school with IESA Bowling Terms and Conditions and additional competition information.
- 4. If you're unsure of how many students are participating, we recommend signing up for the maximum number you anticipate and then dropping entries once you know for sure. Your school can get a full refund for any unused entries if you notify IESA by the initial entry deadline; no refunds will be issued after that deadline.
- 5. Two (2) alternates are allowed per team if your school registers four students in a given division.
- 6. IESA Bowling coaches must meet the IESA Coaching Education requirements (IESA By-Law 2.110) and have passed the state-mandated concussion course (this concussion course is available via your school's member center).
