



VOLLEYBALL UNIFORM CHECKLIST

PRIOR TO THE MATCH

IESA follows NFHS Volleyball Rule 4 for legal uniforms and equipment. Head coaches shall verify with the first referee that all their players are legal and wearing legal uniforms and equipment. Officials should check uniforms prior to the start of the match - NFHS uniform rules must be enforced; if any illegal uniforms are found, officials shall notify the coach of the violation(s) and any issues with uniforms should be addressed at this time.

UNIFORM CHECKLIST - ALL PLAYERS

- Must be worn as intended by the manufacturer
- Hard items are not permitted - buttons, zippers, snaps, fasteners, etc.
- A single partial/whole manufacturer's logo not exceeding 2¼ square inches and with no dimension more than 2¼ inches is permitted on each piece of the uniform
- One American flag not exceeding 2"x3" can be on each piece of the uniform
- If the libero is used, the libero and/or the other teammates must have a solid-colored jersey

UNIFORM TOP CHECKLIST

- Must be like-colored for all teammates
 - Except libero - see "Libero Uniform Top" AND "Solid-Colored Uniform Top" requirements
- Must hang below the waistband or be tucked into the waistband of the bottoms when standing upright
- Numbers
 - Must be permanent and clearly visible
 - No more than 2 digits (00, 0-99) permitted
 - 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08 and 09 are illegal
 - Solid color, plain Arabic numeral at least ¾ inch in width at the narrowest point
 - Trim around the solid number cannot exceed ½ inch in width at the widest point
 - Solid number or the color of the trim around the solid number must be in sharp contrast to the color of the uniform top
 - Must be placed on the front and back no duplicate numbers amongst team
 - 4" height minimum on the front - top of the number must be no more than 5 inches down from the shoulder seam OR the number is centered no more than 5 inches below the bottom edge of any neckline ribbing, placket or seams
 - 6" height minimum on the upper back
- Visible undergarment may be worn under the uniform top
 - T-shirts, body suits, similar garments
 - Must be a single, solid color similar to uniform top color
 - Single manufacturer's logo and/or one single school name/insignia is permitted but neither can exceed 2¼ inches

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Must be like-colored for all teammates <input type="checkbox"/> If there is a number, it must match the uniform top number <input type="checkbox"/> Multiple styles can be worn amongst the team - shorts, spandex, pants and/or skirts <input type="checkbox"/> Visible undergarment may be worn under the uniform bottom <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Must be a single, solid color similar to the uniform bottom color ▪ Must be unadorned ▪ May extend below the uniform bottom 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Black, dark gray, dark green, navy blue, royal blue, dark purple, dark brown, maroon 2. White, yellow, gold, tan, light gray, light blue, light green 3. Pink, red, cardinal red, orange
