2. Online Seeding:

- The IESA will email schools following the closing of step one of the seeding process to remind them that schools may still enter results on the schedule page until the tanking step opens.
- The IESA will continue to instruct schools to only enter 'A' team schedules on the online seeding process. The IESA will include '8th' team schedules to this language in an effort to educate schools as to what an 'A' team schedule means.
- The IESA will add instructions to the seeding process to encourage coaches to add comments and give an example of teams that 'B' squads play 'A' squads.
- 3. Pitch Count was discussed and no change recommended.
- 4. 2011 NFHS rule changes were discussed.
- 5. The extension of the softball season after the state tournament was discussed and what this means to competing teams.
- 6. Defensive Safety Masks were discussed. No recommendation at this time. The committee asked the IESA to survey the membership on masks.
- 7. Composite Bats were discussed. No recommendation at this time.
