To make the following changes to the IESA Speech Terms & Conditions and By-laws:

- 1. To make the following changes:
 - a. To add to 4.087 Props-

Current: This area is not covered currently.

Proposed: Contestants are allowed to interact with audience members without this being considered the introduction of a prop. This would include dialogue and/or physical contact.

RATIONALE: Intent is to provide more guidance to judges.

- 2. To make the following form changes
 - a. Adjudication sheets for Duet Improv and Team Improv: Remove the Time reporting area.

RATIONALE: In these events, the judges control the performance time and any performance allowed to exceed the time requirement by the judge should not be penalized.

b. Nomination forms for Distinguished Service and Class Act: Remove the requirement for teaching years from both forms and only include coaching years.

RATIONALE: The Committee would like to recognize the service of coaches who may not be teachers. **PASSED**

3. To adopt the Film Terms and Conditions

RATIONALE: Proposed roll-out for 2018-19 dependent on facility availability and budget.
