The IESA Basketball Advisory Committee, in its meeting on March 1, 2018, makes the following recommendations to the IESA Board of Directors for their April 6, 2018, meeting:

By-laws and Terms and Conditions Changes/recommendations

Recommendation: 24 games max in a season.

Current: Teams are limited to 22 games.

Proposed: No basketball team representing a member school shall, in any one season and

exclusive to the IESA state series, participate in more than 24 games.

Rationale: Increasing the number of games would help the 8th grade teams who have a 10 day gap

between the end of the regular season and the start of the 8th grade regional.

APPROVED

Recommendation: : A school that fails to enter their season schedule and results, shall be locked out of the seeding process and has no say regarding any seeds.

Current: Schools can still rank other teams if they fail to enter their roster and record.

Proposed: Rewritten-A school that does not enter their roster and/or record will not be able to rank the other

schools in their regional, but those schools can rank them.

Rationale: Teams that are not willing to list games should not be allowed to seed.

(By-law 3.122)
APPROVED

Recommendation: 3 officials for regional championship games. **Current:** Two officials shall be hired for each regional game.

Proposed: Two officials shall be hired for each quarter-final and semi-final regional game.

Three officials will be hired for regional championship games.

Rationale: Having an additional official would provide more court coverage for the Championship game.
