The IESA Softball Advisory Committee makes the following recommendation to the IESA Board of Directors for their January, 2020 meeting:

RECOMMENDATION 1

Proposed	The on-deck batter may use either on-deck circle. The on-deck batter may only take their position during a dead-ball.
Current	NFHS 7-5-1: The on-deck batter shall take a position within the lines of the on-deck circle closest to her dugout.
Rationale	The committee believes that the recommendation allows for greater safety. The on-deck batter would have the option to take a position at the back of the batter to avoid being on the batter's open side. Should the batter switch position, the umpire would have the discretion to allow the on-deck batter to change circles.

POINTS OF EMPHASIS

- Officials are no longer expected to do equipment checks prior to the start of the contest. Coaches are expected to adhere to proper equipment rules and officials are expected to enforce penalties as outlined in the NFHS Softball rules book for illegal equipment.
- 2. Coaches need to instruct fielders and base runners to recognize and avoid instances of interference and obstruction.

GENERAL DISCUSSION TOPICS

- 1. Discussed a proposal regarding the international tie breaker. No recommendation from committee.
- 2. Discussed a proposal regarding a four-class system. No recommendation from committee. Since this was to be the first year of the three-class system, the committee would like to have more data before discussing an additional class.
