The IESA Softball Advisory Committee makes the following recommendation to the IESA Board of Directors for their January, 2022 meeting:

RECOMMENDATION 1

Proposed Change the five team personnel categories to just the heading of team personnel with five open

spots for names.

Current Team personnel is listed as 2 managers, 1 scorekeeper, 2 statisticians

Rationale The committee believes that the recommendation is more inclusive. Many times, non-rostered

players are listed in this area and the general language of "team personnel" would better reflect their season contributions. However, this would not make them eligible for post-season play.

Admin Vote 2-0 in favor Board Action Approved

The Board also approved a recommendation to allow for metal cleats in regular and post-season contests.

POINTS OF EMPHASIS

- 1. Metal cleats are not allowed for regular season or state series play.
- 2. On-deck circle- The on-deck batter may use either on-deck circle. The on-deck batter may only move to the on-deck circle during a dead ball. The on-deck batter must remain in the on-deck circle unless the batter switches hitting positions at which time the umpire would have the discretion to allow the on-deck batter to change circles.

GENERAL DISCUSSION TOPICS

- 1. Discussion of the 2021 season. Glad to have a season and a chance to meet with players.
- 2. Discussed a proposal regarding moving the start date up one/two weeks. No recommendation from committee.
- 3. Discussed a proposal regarding a four-class system. No recommendation from committee. Since this was the first year of the three-class system, the committee would like to have more data before discussing an additional class.
- 4. Discussed two different proposals that would place a time limit on contests. No recommendation from committee.
- 5. Discussed a proposal to require the use of Game Changer. The committee will recommend that teams/schools use Game Changer for the 2022 season. A survey will be sent out to gather data on the number of schools/teams currently using Game Changer.
- 6. Discussed a proposal to reduce the number of innings from 7 to 5. No recommendation from committee.
