	RESPONSIBILITY	COMPLETE?
1.	The higher-seeded team is the host for that regional match. - Communicate with the personnel at your school to ensure the gym is available one hour prior to match time. The playing court shall be set-up and ready for play 45 minutes prior to the scheduled start time	
2.	Notify the IESA of the contest location (street address) and time. * Rounds should be played on the following schedule: * Quarterfinal- 7th- 3/6; 8th- 3/12 * Semifinal- 7th- 3/8, 9; 8th- 3/13 * Championship- 7th- 3/11; 8th- 3/15, 16 The IESA will enter your match information online. If weather presents an issue, please inform the IESA so we can post updated contest information online. Week night matches should not be scheduled prior to 4:30 p.m.	
3.	Volleyballs - Games must begin with at least one volleyball that meets NFHS specifications.
