



Contest Approaching: November 6, 2010

After months of rehearsal, contest is just around the corner. Where has the time gone?

Be sure that contest date is marked in your agenda and on the family home calendar:

Saturday, November G

On that day, students will report to Turner Junior High School by 7:15 a.m. to board a school bus. The entire Speech Team will travel together on the bus to Greenfield High School, where contest will begin at 8:00.

Family members and friends are welcome to attend contest. If students wish to leave contest with their families, a note or e-mail to Mr. Chieman will allow for that to happen.

Mr. Chipman recommends, however, students stay for the entire duration of contest. So much of the fun is watching other students — both from Turner and area schools — perform.

By now the words and blocking of your script should be as familiar to you as your address, the Pledge of Allegiance, your grandmother's social security

You can't fully act until you know your lines and blocking fully.

If you are still struggling to learn your lines, follow these tips - and quickly:

- Run lines with someone at home every night before bed.
- Learn each and every word. That's right: your partner needs the cue from you to know when to come in.
