2010 ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING
MINUTES & RECOMMENDATIONS
April 12, 2010

Introductions were made and a review of the role of the advisory committee took place. The Committee makes the following recommendations to the Board of Directors for its June 18, 2010 meeting:

- 1. Recommendation:** To change the volleyball state tournament time schedule for Tuesday night championship round play. 3rd place match 5:30pm championship match 6:45pm
Approved RATIONALE: The new time schedule for Tuesday should help with late school night travel for teams and fans.
- 2. Recommendation:** Special Awareness Night Guidelines
Approved
- a. All uniforms worn during the special awareness match must meet the standard uniform regulations. This includes having the number on the front and back of the shirt/jersey. There can be no logo endorsement on the shirt other than that of the manufacturer (i.e. Nike, Adidas etc.) You may put your school name on the jersey/shirt as you would any other uniform.
 - b. Officials may wear colored tops for this match.
 - c. A colored ball may be used for this match as long as it meets the NFHS guidelines for such ball. All panels of the ball shall be a maximum combination of three colors, with each panel being a solid color, and if which at least one-third of the panels shall be solid white.
 - d. A school may participate in one special awareness match each school year.
 - e. If your school is hosting a special awareness night for your volleyball season please register your match with the IESA to help us track your promotion. A registration form will be included online.
- RATIONALE: gives guidance to member schools wishing to hold a special awareness event.

4. Other items discussed by the Committee:

- The Rawlings volleyball was discussed and the IESA is currently working with Rawlings to improve the ball over the next two years of play. The problem with the integrity of the bladder will

be fixed for the 2010-11 school year. Due to manufacturing and production line issues this is the only change for this coming year. The exterior of the ball will be worked on for the 2011-12 school year.

- The IESA will permit a colored ball in 2010-11 school year as long as it follows NFHS guidelines. Rawlings will produce a red, white and blue ball for the state series.
- ISAT Testing and regional play was discussed at length and the committee had no recommendations at this time. The committee recommended that each host school communicate with schools in their regional about playing dates and conflicts prior to schedules. Mandatory Saturday play was also discussed by no recommendation made.
- Friday/Saturday state tournaments were discussed, but no recommendation was made.
- Regional Entry form numbers discussed.
- Limiting players to one grade level of play in the state series was discussed.
- Individual limitations were discussed and no recommendation for change was made.
- Warm-up times will remain 4-4-4-2.
- Regular season format changes were discussed, but no changes were made.
- Line Judges were discussed at regional and sectional play for the third year and the committee had no recommendation.
- Boys Volleyball minutes were also shared with the committee.
- The IESA will provide ideas for Special Awareness volleyball match nights.
