## **CHEERLEADING ADVISORY** COMMITTEE MEETING February 20, 2014 Minutes and Recommendations

Introductions were made and a review of the role of the advisory committee took place. The IESA Cheer Advisory Committee, in its meeting of February 20, makes the following recommendations to the IESA Board of Directors for its April 4, 2014 meeting.

## Recommendation #1: To add to the Cheer Terms and Conditions and to revise IESA By-Law 4.155:

Four additional medals will be provided to each division to ensure each member on the roster, including alternates, receive a medal during the awards presentation.

**Rationale:** The amount of medals available should, at the very least, equal the total number of participant slots on the roster form for each division. This will allow each member of the team to leave the Peoria Civic Center with a medal, regardless if they are an alternate or not. Extra medals that may become available can be distributed amongst school administrators, coaches etc. Schools would still have the option to order additional medals at a later date. **Board Action - Approved**

- 6. The Saturday morning facility walkthrough will continue to take place from 7:00am-7:45am.
- 7. The Cheer Championship Judging Panel will be comprised of IHSA and UCA judges.
- 8. The Awards Ceremony has been altered to recognize each individual participant on a winning squad.
  a. The head coach will read off each cheerleader on his or her squad, while a medal is draped over the participant.
