

GOLF ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING AGENDA October 9, 2019

The IESA Golf Advisory Committee makes the following recommendations to the IESA Board of Directors for their January 31, 2020 meeting.

Recommendation: At the sectional, ties will be broken for 2-9th place using the USGA scorecard playoff. If there are any ties for 10th place, one golfer will get the medal and the other ties for 10th will receive their medal at state.

Current: We do not break ties for any place expect for 1st place. If there are ties, one golfer gets the medal. The host course is asked to complete the tie form we provide and send it to us along with any unused medals. We then bring the medals for ties to state to give to the golfers.

Proposed: Break ties for 2-9th place using the USGA scorecard playoff format.

(The method of matching cards should be announced in advance and should also provide what will happen if this procedure does not produce a winner. Matching cards will be used to break a tie using the last nine holes. If the tying players have the same score for the last nine, we will determine the winner on the basis of the last six holes, last three holes and finally the 18th hole. If there is still a tie, then the last six holes, three holes and final hole of the first nine holes will be used.)

Rationale: This will make it easier on the host courses. Courses now only have to tell us the names of the ties for 10th place. This will also makes it more cost effective for the IESA when ordering medals.
