The IESA Cross Country Advisory Committee, in its meeting on November 15, 2023, discussed the following:

Recommendation 1- Terms and Conditions

Current All runners will start from a randomly assigned box. Box assignments will be given to the coach

when they pick up their final packet on the day of the state meet. All individuals who qualify from

a given sectional will all start from the same box.

Proposed All runners will start from a randomly assigned box. Schools with both a girls and a boys team

will be assigned to the same box for each race. Box assignments will be given to the coach when they pick up their final packet on the day of the state meet. All individuals who qualify from a

given sectional will all start from the same box.

Rationale This allows coaches and runners to review one race strategy.

Current Host schools will receive \$1000 for allowable meet expenses. Host schools must complete and

sectional meet. There is no admission fee for spectators at the sectional meet

Proposed Host schools will receive \$1200 for allowable meet expenses. Host schools must complete and

return the Financial Form with required documentation within 14 days of meet completion. Participating schools may not be assessed on a per-team basis to cover operating deficits of a

sectional meet. There is no admission fee for spectators at the sectional meet

Rationale With the majority of meets using a timing company, expenses are exceeding the stipend. Cost is

an additional \$8,000.

Proposed Races are to remain on a consistent schedule as follows: 1A Girls followed by 1A Boys; 2A Girls

followed by 2A Boys; 3A Girls followed by 3A Boys; 4A Girls followed by 4A Boys

Rationale Allows for coaches to prepare consistently from year-to-year.
