Recommendation #1

Current: Boys and girls basketball sectionals start time is 6:30 p.m.

Proposed: Move the sectional start time from 6:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Rationale: Many schools have to travel more than an hour for a sectional on a school night.

Moving the sectional time up a half hour will get them home earlier.

Other Items Discussed

- Regional and sectional assignments
- Seeding recommendations to seed the entire sectional as opposed to regionals.
- Season Schedule- requiring schools to enter scores no later than 48 hours after a game is played.
- Regional start times: Requiring hosts start regional games no later than 10:00 a.m. on a Saturday
- Any school that plays 2 games in one day has to agree to it.
- Keeping the current state series as opposed to moving regionals back to their original dates.
- Wanting to start regional games 15 min early if a game ends early.
- Teams submitting rosters earlier.
- Three second defensive violation.
- Officials-requiring hosts to look at officials rankings before hiring them for regionals.
- Requiring officials to sign the scorebook at the beginning of the game.
- Running clock in the 4th quarter if a team is up 20 pts.
- Stopping the running clock for free throws.
- Regional and sectional hosts must have high school-sized floors to host.
- Have higher seed in regional host quarterfinal games.
- Residency
- Want to raise the game limitations, no number discussed
- Sportsmanship pins- hosts confer with coaches before the regional and sectional championships on who should receive them. One school had a girl receive one at the sectional and state, and the coach said she is one of the meanest girls to players.
- Rules video for parents regarding misunderstood rules.
