## Cooperative Team Agreement between *HOST SCHOOL* and *SUB SCHOOL*

### Introduction

This agreement is made by and between the Board of Education of *(HOST SCHOOL)* and *(SUB SCHOOL)*.

The purpose of this agreement is to expand equal athletic opportunities in the area of *(ACTIVITY)* for *(HOST SCHOOL AND SUB SCHOOL)*.

*(HOST SCHOOL AND SUB SCHOOL)* will split the cost and responsibilities 50-50 *(or whatever agreement is reached between the two school boards)*.

This agreement will be for the *(YEAR 1)* and *(YEAR 2)* school years, upon approval of the IESA. This program will be renewable by mutual agreement between the Boards of Education of the two school districts and the Illinois Elementary School Association.

Notice of non-renewal of this agreement must be given after the second school year of the above term and before the listed deadline as posted on the IESA website.

### Transportation

Each school district will be responsible for arranging transportation for their students to practice sessions and home games. The away games will be split 50-50 relating to which district will provide the bus and driver.

### Squad and Mascot

The squad shall be known as the *(COOP TEAM NAME)* and shall operate with *(COLORS)* uniform colors. The mascot will be the *(COOP MASCOT NAME)*.

### Equipment/Games

*(SCHOOL)* will furnish equipment and uniforms for all participants. All coaching salaries and officials will be split 50-50 *(or whatever agreement is reached between the two school boards)*.

All home games will be split as evenly as possible between the *(HOST SCHOOL'S FACILITIES)* and the *(SUB SCHOOL'S FACILITIES)*. The administrative district shall be responsible for employment of coaching staff *(or whatever agreement is reached between the two school boards)*.

### Supervision

The administration at each district will be responsible for supervision for home games on their grounds. All discipline problems will be the responsibility of the home district.
