Rationale: this is the net height that committee members with teams are currently playing. The NFHS Boys' height is 7'11 5/8"

4. Easter Holiday could impact dates especially at the 7th grade level.

Announcing the dates for the IESA State Tournament Series during the 2024-25 school year allows schools to plan accordingly.

The Committee will meet again on December 5th at 10am to review the survey data before it goes to the IESA Board of Directors in January.

Discussed that the IESA administrative team was supportive of a one level tournament at this time due to costs and numbers. If the board would approve that would there have to be a certain number of schools? Or do we just rip the band aid off and go for it. Also discussed if the board approves, can we add Boys Volleyball to the entry center for next year with a yes / no - must answer before moving on question to the entry.

Discussed bringing to the board an IESA tournament not ending in a state series. Not sure if the board would support this but definitely something I can bring to them. Questions arose about what if there were 80 teams that signed up for the tournament, what would that look like?

Discussed Title IX issues that some schools are facing by not having the same opportunities for the boys as the girls. So does the IESA need to start it and see where it goes.

Discussed that after all the different emerging activities have met that I am really not sure where the board will head but that we seem to be ahead of a couple of the other activities. Also discussed, are we at a tipping point of adding too many activities for member schools.
