NFHS Rule Changes

1-8-6 - Exception & Penalty: A high school coach is now able to use electronic devices in the dugout for one-way communication to the catcher while the team is on defense. The penalty from Rule 3-6-11 was added to Rule 1-8-6 as well, with violators subjected to ejection unless the offense is ruled to be of a minor nature.

Regular Season **Time Limit**

2 Hour Time Limit

No inning can start 2 hours after the first pitch. The clock starts when the 1st pitch is thrown. Home plate umpire will keep the time.



Run Rules still apply.

10-run after 5 innings. 12-run after 4 innings. 15-run after 3 innings.

NFHS Rule Change for Uniforms in 2027





3-6-11: This rule change specifies that coaches are prohibited from using the device to communicate with any other team member while on defense or any team member while on offense and the coach cannot use the device outside of the dugout/bench area.

9-3-2b: When a baserunner who is declared out for being hit by a fair batted ball, the batter-runner is credited with a fielder's choice in the scorebook.

3-2-3 - Beginning January 1, 2027

Uniforms may only bear a single manufacturer's logo, school name, school logo, mascot and/or the participant's name. Advertisements, messages, team slogans, etc. will no longer be permitted.

Frequently Asked Questions ???

Q: Can a softball player on my junior high team also play on a travel team at the same time?

A: This is a local school decision. Coaches, students, and families need to check with the school administration regarding the school's policy on participation on a school team and a non-school team at the same time.

Q: Can a softball player wear jewelry?

A: Yes - umpires still have the authority to rule on anything they deem as dangerous.

IESA By-law 2.053

ISBE Tuition Waiver for children of staff members to attend the school tuition-free, the student shall have eligibility at his/her school of attendance within the district where the parent/guardian is a **full-time staff member**.

Full-time staff member is defined as "a staff member employed and compensated by a school district who works thirty-five (35) or more hours per week for the district during the school year."

Sportsmanship/Ejections

A **player** ejected from a contest must serve a two-game suspension and complete the NFHS Sportsmanship course. A player ejected a second time during the school year must serve a 5-game suspension and the school is responsible for paying a \$100 penalty fee.

A **coach** ejected from a contest must serve a twogame suspension, complete the NFHS Sportsmanship course and the school must pay a \$100 penalty fee. A coach ejected a second time during the school year must serve a 5-game suspension and the school is responsible for paying a \$250 penalty fee. All player/coach ejection consequences must be met, documented and confirmed by the IESA before eligibility is reinstated for a player or a coach.

Fans ejected from a contest must complete the NFHS Sportsmanship course and provide proof of completion to the member school the fan represents before returning to any school contest.
