2024-25 IESA SOCCER ADVISORY MEETING

Minutes and Recommendations October 29, 2024 – IESA Office, Bloomington

The following members were present for the meeting: Nicole Schaefbauer (IESA Executive Director), Reid Savoie, Bradley Central; Scott Hammond, Morton; Patrick Allen, Ottawa Wallace; Dan Sheehan, Monticello; Adam Eucker, Williamsville; Vince Zomboracz, Morris Saratoga; Heather Friedlein, Mendota Northbrook; Adam DeGroot, Shorewood Troy; Sarah Mister, O'Fallon Carriel; Spencer Ferguson, Champaign. Not present was Rodney Monbrum, Coal City.

The IESA Soccer Advisory Committee had the following discussion in its meeting on January 11, 2024.

Discussion Topics

- The Committee had the following thoughts on adding activities to the IESA's offerings: There were concerns
 about the financial impact of adding soccer for the IESA and the member schools. Coaching stipends,
 transportation, uniforms, field, and equipment were among the costs that would directly impact the budgets of
 member schools. Finding facilities and officials was also a concern of the committee. In general, the Committee
 was encouraging of the addition of activities.
- 2. **CALENDAR**: Discussed calendar placement. The Committee has concerns about where the best placement of the season would be so as not to severely impact existing school programs- i.e., baseball, cross country, and track. The Committee has initially recommended the season to be placed in the Spring with the format:
 - a. Practice may begin- Monday Week 37
 - b. Games may begin-Saturday Week 38
 - c. Regionals- Mon./Tues./Wed./Thurs. Week 44
 - d. Sectionals- Wed. Week 45
 - e. State Finals-Tues./Wed. Week 46
- 3. **FORMAT**: The number of participating boys and girls would make it difficult for the majority of schools to put together two separate teams- a boys team and a girls team. Most members of the Committee were in favor of offering soccer as a coed activity. It was mentioned that some schools have indicated that they would not participate if the activity were offered as coed. The Committee decided to survey to see the interest and ability of schools to participate in two separate seasons- a boy's season and a girl's season.
- 4. **OFFICIALS**: The availability of officials was a concern discussed. Those on the Committee who currently participate in soccer indicated that they generally only use one official. That did create some concern regarding possible sportsmanship issues.
- 5. **FACILITIES**: The majority of those on the Committee did not have access to their own field for competitions and practices. Those conducting seasons primarily played on grass.
- 6. **SURVEY**: The Committee proposed to send out a survey to the membership to better assist in their discussion. Survey attached.

Next meeting is scheduled for February 18, 2025 at the IESA Office.
