Welcome to our new member Richton Park Sauk, Rockford Holy Family, Romeoville Hill, and Romeoville Skoff!


We wanted to take a moment to celebrate the 2023-2024 school year with you.

Division Meeting



The IESA Office has been receiving several questions on the following requirement.

Concussion Certification: Per Illinois law, all interscholastic coaches must take an approved concussion course every two years prior to any coaching. This includes assistant coaches, student coaches, and volunteer coaches. Please make sure that your coaches are in compliance with this requirement prior to each season.
