BY-LAW REMINDER: TRANSFER STUDENTS

A student who transfers from one school to another school during the school year will be eligible to participate under the following guidelines:

•The student did not participate in a tryout, organized practice, or contest in that sport at their previous school during the IESA-designated season for that sport.

If the student meets the first criteria and all other eligibility requirements, they would be eligible to participate in a contest for their new school on their eleventh day of attendance.
