Parking

GENERAL PARKING

•General parking will be available in the main, back and side parking lots by the front and back entrances to the school.

- •Additional parking will be available along Taylor Street, by the baseball diamonds.
- •Anyone using a wheelchair should be dropped off at the back entrance.

TEAM BUSES

• The team entrance is located behind the school at Entrance #17. Use the blacktop drive off Taylor Street, next to I-74, to drive behind the school (Lot A) and drop the team off at the entrance. Park buses in the bus lanes adjacent to Taylor Street. Watch for the signs. Only those names on the pass list will be allowed in at this entrance. IESA passes will NOT be recognized for non-team members.

•Teams will be met by a student volunteer, who has been assigned to your team as a guide for the duration of the tournament.

•Coaches, remember only 15 players are allowed to dress for this tournament.

FAN BUSES

• Chaperones are asked to have the students' admission money prepared in advance and ready to submit to tournament personnel. We will meet your bus at the main entrance with wrist bands for each person on your list.

•Fan buses should park in the bus lanes adjacent to Taylor Street to drop off and pick up. Buses also park in the bus lane.

• Bus drivers and chaperones should enter the building at the main entrance and then check in at the admissions table. It is imperative that tournament personnel know where to find these people in case of an emergency.

Video Streaming

• The IESA will not be streaming the games. Spectators are welcome to stream.

Awards

- Individual and team trophies will be presented to the top 4 teams in each class.
- Consolation awards will take place immediately following the 3rd and 4th place game on Thursday night.
- Championship Awards will take place immediately following the championship game.

Signs/Banners/Noisemaking Devices

The display of signs, banners, placards, or similar items at the IESA State Finals (NOT at the Regional or Sectional level) are permitted, provided:

- They reflect good sportsmanship in their message and use.
- They reflect indentification and encouragement to participants and their school/community.
- They are not displayed on the field of play or in a manner which interferes with play.
- They do not obstruct the view of participants or spectators
- They are not a safety hazard.

All light sticks and artificial noise-making devices shall be excluded from the playing area. Tournament managers should not permit spectators to bring megaphones into the playing area for cheering purposes. Cheerleaders may use megaphones for cheering purposes
