Admissions Gate

There will be no reserved seating. The gate will be located at the West entrance of the high school. Teams will also enter the West entrance and WLHS will have a copy of your regional entry form. The gate will be open one hour before the first game on each tournament day.



Parking

- Parking: Buses should unload at the front entrance of the high school and park in the South parking lot. Spectator parking will be available on both the North and South side of the high school main entrance.
- Fan Buses: Schools bringing fan buses are encouraged to purchase digital tickets through the IESA website (GoFan) prior to the tournament. The bus chaperone can then redeem all digital tickets at once upon arrival at the host school. If digital tickets are not purchased, schools should collect the money ahead of time and bring a check made out to "Warrensburg-Latham High School". This check should be presented at the admission gate.

Video Streaming

• The IESA will not be streaming the games. Spectators are welcome to stream.



Awards

- Individual and team trophies will be presented to the top 4 teams in each class.
- Consolation awards will take place immediately following the 3rd and 4th place game on Thursday night.
- Championship Awards will take place immediately following the championship game.

Signs/Banners/Noisemaking Devices

The display of signs, banners, placards, or similar items at the IESA State Finals (NOT at the Regional or Sectional level) are permitted, provided:

- They reflect good sportsmanship in their message and use.
- They reflect identification and encouragement to participants and their school/community.
- They are not displayed on the field of play or in a manner that interferes with play.
- They do not obstruct the view of participants or spectators
- They are not a safety hazard.

All light sticks and artificial noise-making devices shall be excluded from the playing area. Tournament managers should not permit spectators to bring megaphones into the playing area for cheering purposes. Cheerleaders may use megaphones for cheering purposes
