Parking

- **PRIMARY PARKING AREAS:**

- General parking for spectators will be in the may school parking lot.

Video Streaming

- The IESA will not be streaming the games. Spectators are welcome to stream.

Awards

- Individual and team trophies will be presented to the top 4 teams in each class.
- Consolation awards will take place immediately following the 3rd and 4th place game on Thursday night.
- Championship Awards will take place immediately following the championship game on Thursday night.

Signs/Banners/Noisemaking Devices

The display of signs, banners, placards, or similar items at the IESA State Finals (NOT at the Regional or Sectional level) are permitted, provided:

- They reflect good sportsmanship in their message and use.
- They reflect identification and encouragement to participants and their school/community.
- They are not displayed on the field of play or in a manner which interferes with play.
- They do not obstruct the view of participants or spectators
- They are not a safety hazard.

All light sticks and artificial noise-making devices shall be excluded from the playing area. Tournament managers should not permit spectators to bring megaphones into the playing area for cheering purposes. Cheerleaders may use megaphones for cheering purposes
