

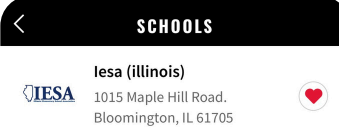
# 7-2A GIRLS VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT GUIDE MARCH 14TH & 15TH

## Parking

- **Team Buses:** should unload in the horseshoe at the front entrance of the school and park in the Brimfield Sports Complex parking lot to the east of the high school. Please do not take buses to the back of the school.
- **Spectators:** Parking will be available in front of the high school in the south parking lot and south of the high school lot at the grade school's west parking lot. There is no parking allowed in the horseshoe drive.

## Awards

- Individual and team trophies will be presented to the top 4 teams in each class.
- Consolation awards will take place immediately following the 3rd and 4th place match on Saturday.
- Championship Awards will take place immediately following the Championship match.



## Signs/Banners/Noisemaking Devices

The display of signs, banners, placards, or similar items at the IESA State Finals (NOT at the Regional or Sectional level) are permitted, provided:

- They reflect good sportsmanship in their message and use.
- They reflect identification and encouragement to participants and their school/community.
- They are not displayed on the field of play or in a manner which interferes with play.
- They do not obstruct the view of participants or spectators
- They are not a safety hazard.

All light sticks and artificial noise-making devices shall be excluded from the playing area. Tournament managers should not permit spectators to bring megaphones into the playing area for cheering purposes. Cheerleaders are not permitted.
