Mikasa Parking

- **Bus Parking:** Team buses should empty and load at the pass gate entrance on the south side of the building. Team buses should park on the northeast side of the building or the west parking lot.
- **Spectator Parking:** General parking will be available in the parking lots on the east, south and west side of the school. Parking also will be available along the streets. Please do not block driveways or alleys.



Video Streaming

Mikasa Awards

- Individual and team trophies will be presented to the top 4 teams in each class.
- Consolation awards will take place immediately following the 3rd and 4th place match on Saturday.
- Championship Awards will take place immediately following the Championship match.



Signs/Banners/Noisemaking Devices

The display of signs, banners, placards, or similar items at the IESA State Finals (NOT at the Regional or Sectional level) are permitted, provided:

- They reflect good sportsmanship in their message and use.
- They reflect indentification and encouragement to participants and their school/community.
- They are not displayed on the field of play or in a manner which interferes with play.
- They do not obstruct the view of participants or spectators
- They are not a safety hazard.

All light sticks and artificial noise-making devices shall be excluded from the playing area. Tournament managers should not permit spectators to bring megaphones into the playing area for cheering purposes. Cheerleaders are not permitted.
